ENTERTAINMENT:

1. On Friday and Saturday a licensed security person shall patrol the areas adjacent to the licensed premises ('the block') from midnight to 4am in the morning to ensure patrons leave the adjacent area without causing undue noise and disturbance to nearby residents.
2. Live entertainment is restricted to low key single/duos, acoustic/jazz entertainment.
3. There shall be no rock/heavy metal bands/disco music.
4. All music entertainment is to be played through the in-house system.
5. Noise from the premises (including live or recorded entertainment, signing patron noise or similar) when assessed at the nearest noise sensitive location shall be less than 8 dB(A) above the level of background noise in any octave band of the sound spectrum.
6. The beer garden (Area 3) shall trade no later than 11.30 pm.
7. There shall be no entertainment provided in (Area 3) the beer garden.

CONDITIONS:

1. Entertainment in Areas 4 shall only be provided between 12 noon to 9pm everyday.
2. There shall be no amplified music in Area 4 after 9pm.
3. Where entertainment is conducted after 1am on any day, adequate approved crowd controllers will be engaged to control patron behaviour while on and as they leave the premises.
4. That the licensee will erect a 1.5m high fence across the carpark area from the fence on the eastern boundary of the hotel to the hotel building, within 4 months of the date of this order.
